Recommendations for accommodation in York

I can suggest three hotels (see below).

The **Premier Inns** are always reliable.

I've not stayed at the **Bar Convent**, but I've been there many times for coffee and light meals. I imagine the accommodation will be very pleasant. However, there is no parking and people would have to use the Nunnery Lane car park which is expensive (as are all the car parks in York). To be honest, I would not consider driving to York; I'd always choose the train.

I have eaten at the **Principal** - and have heard that the accommodation is satisfactory. It is right next to the station - literally two minutes away. And there is parking. However, it might be expensive.

Premier Inn, York City (Blossom St North):

There is limited parking at this hotel which is allocated on a first come, first served basis and is chargeable.

Bar Convent Guest House, Blossom Street, York

Situated in the heart of York, The Bar Convent is only a 15-minute minute walk from the city centre and just over 300 metres from York Railway Station.

The Bar Convent, as a Grade I Listed building, does not have its own parking facilities.

There is a pay and display long stay car park just around the corner on Nunnery Lane. This car park now has facilities to Park and Pay by phone on arrival. The number to call is 0870 4283854. Quote location number 7709 and you will be able to select the number of hours you wish to pay for using your credit/debit card.

If this car park is full, then alternative parking is available by using the Park and Ride car park at Askham Bar.
